
By Mr. Navin of Marlborough, petition of the Federation of State, City and Town Employees, Ind., for a cost-of-living salary increase for certain officers and employees of the Commonwealth and for certain blind workers. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE A COST-OF-LIVING SALARY INCREASE FOR CERTAIN OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND FOR CERTAIN BLIND WORKERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Each officer and employee of the commonwealth
2 holding an office or position subject to the provisions of sections
3 forty-six to fifty, inclusive, of chapter thirty of the General Laws
4 shall receive in addition to the salary payable to him in accord-
5 ance with the provisions of said sections and the salary schedule
6 set forth in section forty-six of said chapter thirty an increase of
7 three hundred and sixty dollars excluding statutory positions
8 and elected officers.

1 SECTION 2. The wages paid to blind workers by the division
2 of the blind in the department of education, as provided by sec-
3 tion fourteen of chapter sixty-nine of the General Laws, shall be
4 increased over the rate paid on June thirtieth, nineteen hundred
5 and sixty-two by three hundred and sixty dollars.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect as of July first, nineteen
2 hundred and sixty-two.
