AN ACT RELATIVE TO LOCAL REPRESENTATION ON THE ADVISORY BOARD OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WELFARE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 18 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 25 of chapter 730 of the acts of 1955, is
3 hereby further amended by inserting after the first sentence
4 the following sentence:— Three members shall be directors of
5 local welfare departments or local welfare districts.
