

HOUSE No. 1716

By Mr. Dower of Athol, petition of Harold L. Dower relative to providing tenure of office for Paul P. Jerris, incumbent of the office of town accountant of the town of Athol. Towns.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE TENURE FOR PAUL P. JERRIS, INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF TOWN ACCOUNTANT OF THE TOWN OF ATHOL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The tenure of office of Paul P. Jerris, incumbent
2 of the office of town accountant of the town of Athol, shall, upon
3 the effective date of this act, be unlimited but he may be re-
4 moved therefrom for cause after hearing in the manner provided
5 by section forty-three of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted to the voters of said
2 town for acceptance at the annual town meeting in the current
3 year in the form of the following question, which shall be placed
4 on the official ballot to be used for the election of town officers
5 at said meeting:—“Shall an act passed by the General Court
6 in the current year, entitled ‘An Act to provide tenure for Paul
7 P. Jerris, incumbent of the office of town accountant of the town
8 of Athol’, be accepted?” If a majority of votes in answer to
9 said question is in the affirmative, this act shall thereupon take
10 full effect, but not otherwise.
