## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE NUMBER OF LIQUOR LICENSES IN CITIES AND TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 17 of chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the last paragraph, inserted by chapter  
3 691 of the acts of 1960, and inserting in place thereof the fol-  
4 lowing paragraph:—

5 Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, each city and  
6 town shall on January first of each year reduce the number of  
7 liquor licenses so that there shall be no more than one such  
8 license for every one thousand inhabitants in said city or town.
