AN ACT REQUIRING PLUMBERS TO KNOW GAS FITTING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of chapter 142 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the second sentence, as appearing in the
3 Tercentenary Edition, and inserting in place thereof the follow-
4 ing sentence:— They shall examine each applicant desiring
5 to engage in the business of a master plumber or to work as a
6 journeyman, as to his practical knowledge of gas fitting, plumb-
7 ing, house drainage and plumbing ventilation, and subject him
8 to a practical test satisfactory to the examiners, who if satisfied
9 of his competence shall issue to him a license as applied for.
