AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO TRANSFER CONTROL OF THE NORTH READING STATE SANATORIUM TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The commissioner of public health is hereby au-
2 thorized and directed to transfer control of the land, buildings
3 and equipment, known as the North Reading state sanatorium,
4 located on Route 62, North Reading, from the department of
5 public health to the department of public safety for its use as a
6 state police academy.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
