AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO  
APPOINT THREE ELEVATOR INSPECTORS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 62 of chapter 143 of the General Laws, as most re-  
2 cently amended by chapter 519 of the acts of 1957, is hereby  
3 further amended by striking out the fifth sentence and insert-  
4 ing in place thereof the following sentence:—The commis-  
5 sioner shall appoint three inspectors and assign them to inspect  
6 all elevators in cities and towns in the districts not having an  
7 approved system of elevator inspection.
