RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SPECIAL COMMISSION TO ERECT A SUITABLE SCULPTURE OF JOHN F. KENNEDY, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two mem-
2 bers of the senate to be designated by the president thereof,
3 two members of the house of representatives to be designated
4 by the speaker thereof, and to persons to be appointed by the
5 governor shall, with the approval of the art commission, provide
6 for the establishment on the grounds of the State House of a
7 life sized statue of John F. Kennedy, president of the United
8 States, to preserve for future generations the high regard of
9 the people of the commonwealth for the public service of John
10 F. Kennedy as a United States representative, a United States
11 senator and as president of the United States. The said com-
12 mission shall give consideration to the advisability of obtaining
13 the services of Gilberto Rocci of Milano, Italy, to erect said
14 statue, and the commission may expend for the purposes hereof
15 such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
