The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

Ordered, That the Legislative Research Council be directed to conduct a study relating to the taxation of trailers, trailer parks, and so-called mobile homes. Said council shall report to the General Court the results of its study by filing the same with the Clerk of the House not later than the last Wednesday of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-three.
