AN ACT RELATIVE TO NOTIFYING PARTIES OF RECORD OF TRIAL  
DATES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 231 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 84A the following section:—
- 3 *Section 84B.* The clerk of court who notifies attorneys of
- 4 record of any trial date, shall at the same time, notify the parties
- 5 of record in the same matter.
