AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A CLOTHING ALLOWANCE FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 21 is hereby amended by striking out section 5A and
- 2 inserting in place thereof the following section:—
- 3 *Section 5A.* The director of the division of law enforcement
- 4 may, with the approval of the commissioner, prescribe by rules
- 5 and regulations a standard form or forms of uniforms to be worn
- 6 by members of the enforcement units. Such uniform or any
- 7 descriptive part thereof so prescribed shall be worn only by per-
- 8 sonnel of said division entitled thereto under said rules and regu-
- 9 lations. The sum of one hundred dollars shall be expended for
- 10 the upkeep of said uniform or uniforms for such persons so au-
- 11 thorized. Violation of this section shall be punishable by a fine
- 12 of not less than ten nor more than one hundred dollars.
