### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE RESTORATION OF CERTAIN COMPENSATION OF TEMPORARY CLERKS AND TEMPORARY ASSISTANT CLERKS OF DISTRICT COURTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 9 of chapter 218 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by striking out the second sentence, as appear-  
3 ing in section 1 of chapter 526 of the acts of 1961, and inserting  
4 in place thereof the following sentence:— A temporary clerk  
5 shall be paid by the county for each day's service an amount  
6 equal to the rate by the day of the compensation of the clerk of  
7 such court as established in the salary schedule set forth in sec-  
8 tion seventy-nine; but compensation so paid to a temporary  
9 clerk for service, in excess of thirty days in any one year, shall  
10 be deducted by the county treasurer from the salary of the  
11 clerk; provided, however, that if a clerk is absent, due to his  
12 illness or physical disability, for a period not exceeding thirty  
13 days in any year, in addition to said thirty days, he shall be  
14 deemed to be on sick leave and no such deduction shall be made.

1 SECTION 2. Section 11 of said chapter 218 is hereby amended  
2 by striking out the second sentence, as appearing in section 2 of  
3 said chapter 526, and inserting in place thereof the following  
4 sentence:— A temporary assistant clerk shall be paid by the  
5 county for each day's service an amount equal to the rate by the

6 day of the compensation of such assistant clerk as established  
7 by section eighty; but compensation so paid to a temporary  
8 assistant clerk for service, in excess of thirty days in any one  
9 year, shall be deducted by the county treasurer from the salary  
10 of such assistant clerk; provided, however, that if an assistant  
11 clerk is absent, due to his illness or physical disability, for a  
12 period not exceeding thirty days in any year, in addition to said  
13 thirty days, he shall be deemed to be on sick leave and no such  
14 deduction shall be made.
