AN ACT PROVIDING CIVIL SERVICE EMPLOYMENT WITHOUT EXAMINATION FOR HOLDERS OF THE DISTINGUISHED FLYING CROSS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 22 of chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out the second paragraph, inserted by chapter 345
3 of the acts of 1946, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 paragraph:—

5 A person who has received a distinguished service cross, a
6 distinguished flying cross or navy cross may, upon the recom-
7 mendation of the director and with the approval of the commis-
8 sion, be appointed under the same conditions as are provided in
9 this section in the case of a person who has received a medal of
10 honor.
