AN ACT TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO CITIES AND TOWNS IN THE IMPROVEMENT OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5 of chapter 645 of the acts of 1948, is hereby amended
2 by striking out the definition "Approved school project", as
3 most recently amended by chapter 703 of the acts of 1957, and
4 inserting in place thereof the following definition:—
5 "Approved school project" shall mean any project for the
6 construction, improvement or enlargement of a regional, con-
7 solidated or county agricultural school, or of any public school-
8 house in any city or town, and shall include the original equip-
9 ment and furnishings, whether movable or built in, to complete
10 said project, the contract or contracts for which shall have been
11 awarded on or after January first, nineteen hundred and forty-
12 six, by any city, town, county or regional school building com-
13 mittee, which has been approved by the commission for the
14 purposes of sections seven through nine, inclusive.
