## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CORE THE JETTY IN THE GREEN HARBOR DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF MARSHFIELD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subject to the conditions herein imposed, the  
2 department of public works, acting through its division of water-  
3 ways, is hereby authorized and directed to core the jetty at the  
4 entrance to Green Harbor basin in the Green Harbor district  
5 of the town of Marshfield.

1 SECTION 2. No work shall be begun hereunder until the town  
2 of Marshfield has paid into the state treasury a sum of money  
3 representing the town's share of the total amount to be spent  
4 under this act and the county of Plymouth has paid into the  
5 state treasury a sum of money representing the county's share  
6 of the total amount to be spent under this act, which, together  
7 with a sum of money representing fifty per cent of the total  
8 amount to be spent, as may hereafter be appropriated by the  
9 commonwealth, shall constitute a fund for the improvements  
10 herein authorized; provided that the total cost of such improve-  
11 ments shall not exceed forty-four thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 3. The cost of the work under this act shall be paid  
2 as follows:— fifty per cent by the commonwealth, twenty-five  
3 per cent by said county, and twenty-five per cent by said town.
