The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ATTACHMENT OF A NOTIFICATION TO CERTAIN VEHICLES TAGGED FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 20A of chapter 90 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence, as
3 most recently amended by chapter 404 of the acts of 1956, and
4 inserting in place thereof the following sentence:— No other
5 form of notice, except as provided in this section, shall be given
6 to the offender; and no notification shall be attached to the vehi-
7 cle involved except as follows:— in the city of Boston the follow-
8 ing notification may be attached to the vehicle involved:— This
9 tag has been attached because of a parking violation and must be
10 returned by mail or personally to the police department within
11 four days filled in with your name, address and license number;
12 if this notification is returned as directed, no further action will
13 be taken against you unless this is a second or subsequent offence;
14 in the city of Cambridge a notification may be attached to a
15 motor vehicle registered under the laws of another state or
16 country which shall read as follows:— This tag has been at-
17 tached because of a parking violation and must be returned by
18 mail or personally to the traffic division within four days filled
19 in with your name, address and license number; if this notifica-
20 tion is returned as directed, you will receive in hand or by mail
21 the notice of a parking violation described in section twenty A of
22 chapter ninety of the General Laws.
