AN ACT CLARIFYING THE PROVISIONS REGULATING OVERTIME IN THE COMMONWEALTH OF MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 151A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out in section 3 after the word "executive," the words
3 "or administrative or professional" and inserting therefor the
4 words:—administrative, professional or managerial,—so that
5 the section shall read as follows:—*Section 3.* As a bona fide
6 executive, administrative, professional or managerial person
7 earning more than eighty dollars per week.

104. (1) Every company shall have a directors' report to be prepared by the directors at the annual general meeting of the company.
