In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two

AN ACT TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR INDUCING OR PERMITTING ANOTHER TO RESORT TO CERTAIN LICENSED PREMISES FOR IMMORAL PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 26 of chapter 272 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the word "acts" in line 7 the words:—
3 and any person owning, managing or controlling such place and
4 any employee of such person who induces or knowingly suffers
5 any person to resort to, or be in such place for the purpose of
6 immoral solicitation or immoral bargaining.
