AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF A CERTAIN CLERK TO
ACT AS DEPUTY REGISTER FOR HAMPDEN COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 217 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
- 2 serting after section 29 the following section:—
- 3 *Section 29A.* The register of probate for Hampden county
- 4 may designate an employee of his office as deputy assistant
- 5 register with the same powers as an assistant register and may
- 6 revoke any such designation at pleasure.
