AN ACT GRANTING CREDITABLE SERVICE TO A MEMBER OF THE TEACHERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM WHO IS ON AN AUTHORIZED LEAVE OF ABSENCE UNDER A FULBRIGHT, SMITH MUNDT OR JOHN HAY FELLOWSHIP.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Paragraph (c) of subdivision 1 of section 4 of chapter 32 of
2 the General Laws, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 658 of
3 the acts of 1945, is hereby amended by inserting after the
4 first sentence the following sentence:— Creditable service in
5 the case of a member of the teachers' retirement system shall
6 include any period not in excess of one year without regular
7 compensation while he is on authorized leave of absence under
8 a Fulbright, Smith Mundt or John Hay Fellowship.
