

HOUSE No. 2321

By Mr. Chmura of Holyoke, petition of Josephine L. Bolduc and others that provision be made for the determination by the voters of the town of Shrewsbury of whether or not the water supply of said town shall continue to be fluoridated. Public Health.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF SHREWSBURY SHALL DETERMINE WHETHER OR NOT THE WATER SUPPLY OF SAID TOWN SHALL CONTINUE TO BE FLUORIDATED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The following question shall be placed upon the official ballot
2 to be used for the election of officers at the annual town meeting
3 to be held in the year nineteen hundred and sixty-two in the
4 town of Shrewsbury:—"Shall the fluoridation of the water
5 supply of the town of Shrewsbury be continued?" If a majority
6 of the votes in answer to said question is in the affirmative, the
7 fluoridation of the water supply of said town shall be continued;
8 otherwise it shall be discontinued.
