

HOUSE No. 2333

By Mr. Crane of Boston, petition of Charles Francis Mahoney for legislation to increase salaries of the Commissioner and associate commissioners of the Department of Public Works. Public Service.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STONE AND WEBSTER RECOMMENDATION THAT THE SALARIES OF THE COMMISSIONER AND ASSOCIATE COMMISSIONERS OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS BE INCREASED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 16 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 717 of the acts of 1956, is
3 hereby further amended by striking out, in line 9, the word
4 "fifteen" and inserting in place thereof the word:— twenty,
5 — and by striking out, in line 10, the word "ten" and inserting
6 in place thereof the word fifteen, — so as to read as follows:—
7 *Section 2.* There shall be a department of public works which
8 shall be under the supervision and control of a commissioner
9 of public works and two associate commissioners. Upon the
10 expiration of the term of office of a commissioner or of an asso-
11 ciate commissioner his successor shall be appointed for five years
12 by the governor. The commissioner shall receive a salary of
13 twenty thousand dollars. The associate commissioners shall
14 receive such salaries not exceeding fifteen thousand dollars as
15 the commissioner may determine. The commissioner and as-
16 sociate commissioners shall be allowed their actual traveling
17 and other necessary expenses.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on January first, nine-
2 teen hundred and sixty-three.
