## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

### AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE COURT OFFICERS OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-  
2 ing out section 82A, as most recently amended by section 1  
3 of chapter 788 of the acts of 1951, and inserting in place thereof  
4 the following section: —

5 *Section 82A.* Each officer in attendance upon the municipal  
6 court of the city of Boston who is appointed under section sixty-  
7 one shall receive from the county of Suffolk in full for all services  
8 performed by him the following salary: — The chief court officers,  
9 sixty-four per cent of the salary of the clerk of the court; the  
10 assistant chief court officers, sixty-one per cent of the salary of  
11 the clerk of the court; and all other court officers, fifty-eight  
12 per cent of the salary of the clerk of the court.
