AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF PERSONNEL AND STANDARDIZATION TO REALLOCATE THE POSITION OF INVESTIGATOR IN THE REGISTRY OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

2 to the contrary, the director of personnel and standardization  
3 is hereby authorized and directed to reallocate the position of  
4 investigator in the registry of motor vehicles from job group  
5 twelve to job group fourteen.
