AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE GREYLOCK RESERVATION COMMISSION TO RESTORE, REPAIR AND CHANGE THE STRUCTURAL DESIGN OF THE MOUNT GREYLOCK WAR MEMORIAL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Greylock Reservation commission is hereby authorized
- 2 and directed to restore, repair and change the structural design
- 3 of the Mount Greylock War Memorial, and for said purpose may
- 4 expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
