AN ACT TO CONTROL CONFLICT OF INTEREST IN REPRESENTATIVE TOWN GOVERNMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 43A of the General Laws, as amended, is hereby fur-
2 ther amended by adding thereto the following new section: —
3 *Section 4A. Conflict of Interest.*—Notwithstanding any pro-
4 vision of this chapter or any other general or special law to the
5 contrary, no person shall be a member of a representative town
6 meeting who is also an official or employee of that town.
