

By Mr. Berry of Peabody, petition of Anthony J. Vorel, John T. Berry and another relative to the use of new wards and certain precincts thereof in the city of Peabody in nominating and electing Representatives to the General Court. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF NEW WARDS AND CERTAIN PRECINCTS THEREOF IN THE CITY OF PEABODY IN NOMINATING AND ELECTING REPRESENTATIVES TO THE GENERAL COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of section four of
2 chapter fifty-four of the General Laws, or of chapter two hundred
3 and eighteen of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty to the
4 contrary, the seven wards into which the city of Peabody was
5 redivided by the city council of said city in the year nineteen
6 hundred and sixty, hereinafter referred to as new wards, shall
7 be used for all primaries and elections held in said city and for
8 such purposes election officers shall be appointed and voting
9 lists shall be prepared and all other things required by law shall
10 be done in accordance with said new wards.

1 SECTION 2. The tenth Essex representative district shall
2 until the next decennial apportionment, conformably with the
3 constitution, be as follows, the territory comprising said district
4 remaining the same as at the time of its formation:—

5 Tenth Essex:—In the city of Peabody, wards two, three,
6 four, five, new ward six and new ward seven.

7 For the purposes of nominating and electing representatives
8 and of submitting questions of public policy to the voters in
9 said representative district all things shall be done in said repre-
10 sentative district as if said new wards thereof had existed and
11 had constituted, in part, the basis for determining representa-
12 tive districts at the time of the formation of said tenth Essex
13 representative district.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
