AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO RECOMMEND THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE CHARTERS OF INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING IN CERTAIN CASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 69 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-
2 serting after section 31, inserted by section 3 of chapter 549 of
3 the acts of 1943, the following section: —

4 *Section 31A.* The department of education shall, every five
5 years, review the curriculum, faculty and facilities of each in-
6 stitution of higher learning chartered to grant degrees, and said
7 department shall recommend to the department of corporations
8 and taxation the withdrawal of the charter of any such insti-
9 tution whenever in its opinion said institution is not being con-
10 ducted in the manner contemplated by the granting of said
11 charter.
