AN ACT RELATIVE TO DEANS OF ADMISSION AND STUDIES AT CERTAIN STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 69 of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-
- 2 ing after section 32 the following section: —
- 3 *Section 33.* Each state-controlled institution of higher learn-
- 4 ing shall be entitled to a dean of admissions and a dean of studies
- 5 to be employed on a full time twelve months basis, and at a rate
- 6 of pay two grades above that of a full professor in the same insti-
- 7 tution. Such personnel shall have the same professional qualifi-
- 8 cations of education and experience as a full professor at the
- 9 institution. These positions shall not be counted in the student-
- 10 faculty ratios used in budget computation.
