## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TRUSTEES OF THE NEW BEDFORD VOCATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO GRANT THE DEGREES OF ASSOCIATE IN ARTS AND ASSOCIATE IN SCIENCE TO STUDENTS COMPLETING COURSES OF INSTRUCTION ON A POST HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 74 of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-
- 2 ing after section 24A the following section: —
- 3 *Section 24B.* With the approval of the board of collegiate
- 4 authority, the trustees of the New Bedford vocational high
- 5 school may grant the degrees of associate in arts and associate
- 6 in science to students who satisfactorily complete the required
- 7 technical courses of instruction offered by said school on a post
- 8 high school level.
