## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE ISSUANCE OF A BUILDING PERMIT BY TOWNS IN BARNSTABLE COUNTY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 A building permit shall not be issued in any town in the county  
2 of Barnstable until a public hearing shall be held relative to the  
3 granting of said permit. Notice of said hearing shall be given  
4 at least ten days before the date thereof by publication in a  
5 newspaper having circulation in said town. The building com-  
6 missioner or proper authority of a town shall conduct the hearing  
7 and give due notice to any objections relative to the granting of  
8 said permit.

9 The provisions of this act shall be applicable to any permit  
10 which has been granted before the effective date hereof provided  
11 that work has not been started under said permit.

The Constitution of the State

Article I

Section 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.
