Kelly that the Metropolitan Transit Authority be directed to construct a pedestrian crossing at the intersection of Washington Street, Morton Street, the Arborway and Antiscou Road at Forest Hills Station in the Jamaica Plain district of Boston. AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT A PEDESTRIAN CROSSING AT THE INTERSECTION OF WASHINGTON STREET, MORTON STREET, THE ARBORWAY, AND ANTISCOU ROAD AT THE FOREST HILLS STATION IN JAMAICA PLAIN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Metropolitan Transit Authority is hereby authorized
2 and directed to construct a suitable pedestrian crossing, under-
3 pass or overpass, to facilitate the crossing of pedestrians into
4 the Forest Hills Station at the intersection of Washington street,
5 Morton street, the Arborway, and Antiscou road in Jamaica
6 Plain.

7 The Metropolitan Transit Authority may expend such sums
8 as may be appropriated therefor.
