By Mr. Albro of Harwich, petition of Maurice W. Wiley (selectman) for legislation to increase the amount of money which the town of Eastham may appropriate for municipal advertising purposes and for public amusements. Municipal Finance.

AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF MONEY THE TOWN OF EASTHAM MAY APPROPRIATE FOR MUNICIPAL ADVERTISING PURPOSES AND FOR PUBLIC AMUSEMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Eastham may, by a majority vote,
2 appropriate each year a sum not exceeding two thousand dollars
3 for advertising the advantages of the town and for providing
4 amusements or entertainments of a public character. The money
5 so appropriated by the town shall be expended under the direc-
6 tion of the board of selectmen.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter four of the acts of nineteen hundred and
2 sixty-one is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
