AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF TWO INVESTIGATORS ON THE STATE BOXING COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 22 of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-
2 ing after section 12 the following section:—

3 *Section 12A.* The commissioner shall appoint two persons to
4 act as investigators for the commission who shall, in co-operation
5 with the state police, make such investigations as may be neces-
6 sary for the proper conduct of said commission.
