AN ACT PROVIDING FOR UNIFORMS TO BE WORN BY COURT OFFICERS IN THE DISTRICT COURTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-
2 ing out section 63, as most recently amended by chapter 341 of
3 the acts of 1935, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section:—

5 *Section 63.* Court officers in district courts in Suffolk county
6 shall, while on duty in said courts, wear uniforms to be ap-
7 proved by the justices of said courts, which shall be furnished at
8 the expense of said county. In counties other than Suffolk,
9 court officers receiving stated salaries, in attendance upon full
10 time district courts within the commonwealth, shall while on
11 duty in said courts wear uniforms which shall be designated by
12 the administrative committee of the district courts. Such uni-
13 forms for court officers aforesaid in attendance upon full time
14 district courts within the commonwealth, shall be furnished at
15 the expense of their respective counties.
