RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE EFFICIENCY OF COUNTY GOVERNMENT.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of
2 two members of the senate to be designated by the president
3 thereof, three members of the house of representatives to be
4 designated by the speaker thereof, and three members to be
5 appointed by the governor, is hereby established for the purpose
6 of making an investigation and study relative to improving
7 the efficiency and effectiveness of county government. Said
8 commission shall be provided with quarters in the state house
9 or elsewhere, may travel within or without the commonwealth
10 and may expend for clerical or expert services, and for such
11 other services and expenses as may be necessary or desirable to
12 accomplish the purposes of this resolve, such sums as may be
13 appropriated therefor. Said commission shall report to the gen-
14 eral court the results of its investigation and study, and its recom-
15 mendations, if any, with drafts of legislation necessary to carry
16 said recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the
17 the clerk of the house of representatives not later than the fourth
18 Wednesday of December in the year nineteen hundred and sixty-
19 two.
