## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE TRUSTEES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS TO SELECT AND DESIGNATE A SUITABLE BUILDING ON ITS GROUNDS IN MEMORY OF THE LATE REPRESENTATIVE EDWIN D. GORMAN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The trustees of the University of Massachusetts are hereby  
2 authorized and directed to select and designate a suitable build-  
3 ing on the grounds of the university in memory of the late  
4 Representative Edwin D. Gorman. A suitable placque to this  
5 effect shall be placed in said building. For said purpose they  
6 shall expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
