RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY RELATIVE TO THE ADVISABILITY OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A LAW SCHOOL AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS IN AMHERST.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to consist of  
2 three members of the senate to be designated by the president  
3 thereof, five members of the house of representatives to be desig-  
4 nated by the speaker thereof, and five persons to be appointed  
5 by the governor, is hereby established for the purpose of making  
6 an investigation and study relative to the advisability of the  
7 establishment of a law school at the University of Massachusetts  
8 in Amherst.

9 Said commission shall be provided with quarters in the state  
10 house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may travel within the  
11 commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and other assistance  
12 and for expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor.  
13 Said commission shall report to the general court the results of  
14 its investigation and study and its recommendations, if any,  
15 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-  
16 mendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk of the  
17 house of representatives on or before the fourth Wednesday of  
18 December in the current year.
