By Mr. Clark of Easthampton, petition of John G. Clark that the Department of Public Works be directed to install riprap on a portion of the bank of the Connecticut River in the town of Hadley. Harbors and Public Lands.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO INSTALL RIPRAP ON A PORTION OF THE BANK OF THE CONNECTICUT RIVER IN THE TOWN OF HADLEY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The department of public works is hereby authorized and di-
- 2 rected to install riprap on the east bank of the Connecticut river
- 3 for a distance of fifteen hundred feet, starting at a point nine hun-
- 4 dred feet north of the Coolidge Memorial bridge in the town of
- 5 Hadley. For the purposes of this act, said department may ex-
- 6 pend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE

ARTICLE I. OF THE CONSTITUTION.

SECTION 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

SECTION 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

SECTION 3. The Senate of the United States shall be composed of two Senators from each State, chosen by the Legislature thereof, for six Years; and each Senator shall have the Qualifications requisite for Senators of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.
