By Mr. Patrone of Boston, petition of Charles L. Patrone for legislation relative to the location of driver training schools. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF LOCATING DRIVER SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 32G of chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out paragraph 3 and inserting in place
3 thereof the following paragraph:—

4 No license shall be issued or renewed for conducting a driver
5 school in a city having a population of one hundred thousand or
6 more, if the place of business of such school or branch thereof is
7 within seven hundred and fifty feet of a building owned, leased
8 or used by the registry of motor vehicles for the examination of
9 applicants for operators' licenses or for the issuance of operators'
10 licenses to the public, but the registrar may waive this provision.
11 The said distance of seven hundred and fifty feet shall be meas-
12 ured along the public streets by the nearest route from such
13 place of business, or branch thereof, to such building.
