

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 2732

By Mr. Patrone of Boston, petition of Charles L. Patrone that mail-order firms and retail or department stores be prohibited from soliciting the sale of motor vehicle liability insurance policies or public liability insurance policies. Insurance.

## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SALE OR SOLICITATION FOR THE SALE OF MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY POLICIES OR PUBLIC LIABILITY POLICIES BY MAIL-ORDER FIRMS, RETAIL OR DEPARTMENT STORES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 175 of the General Laws is hereby amended by in-  
2 serting after section 193E the following section:—

3 *Section 193F.* It shall be unlawful for any mail order firm or  
4 branch thereof or any retail or department store or branch  
5 thereof to sell, offer for sale, solicit or allow any person in or  
6 about any building to sell, offer for sale or solicit a motor vehicle  
7 liability policy or public liability policy.

8 Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of  
9 this act shall be fined not more than one thousand dollars.
