By Mr. Kenneally of Boston, petition of George V. Kenneally, Jr., that the city of Boston be authorized to convey all or a portion of the Dorchester Park Reservation to the Metropolitan District Commission for recreational purposes. Metropolitan Affairs.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO CONVEY ALL OR A PORTION OF THE DORCHESTER PARK RESERVATION TO THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The mayor and the park commission of the city
2 of Boston are hereby authorized on behalf of said city to convey
3 or otherwise transfer without consideration to the metropolitan
4 district commission in the name of the commonwealth for recrea-
5 tional purposes all or any portion of a certain parcel of land now
6 known as Dorchester Park reservation, located in the Dorchester
7 district of said city, and now held by said city for park purposes.
8 Upon acquisition of said parcel of land the metropolitan district
9 commission shall maintain and construct a recreational area with
10 suitable structures and facilities thereon.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
