AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF A PATROL BOAT TO BE USED FOR THE PRESERVATION AND PROTECTION OF THE FISH AND FISHERIES RESOURCES OF THE COMMONWEALTH BY THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 For the purpose of making possible further scientific studies
2 and for the preservation and protection of the marine fish and
3 fisheries resources of the commonwealth, the department of
4 natural resources, acting through the division of law enforce-
5 ment, is hereby authorized to expend the sum of thirty-five
6 thousand dollars, and such additional sums as may be appro-
7 priated therefor, for the preparation of plans and specifications,
8 and the building of a suitable patrol boat fully equipped, in-
9 cluding such modern electronic devices as is suitable and adapted
10 for patrol boat purposes.
