AN ACT AUTHORIZING PAY RAISES FOR ALL STATE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any provisions of the law to the contrary,
- 2 all employees of the commonwealth shall be granted a pay raise
- 3 of four hundred and twenty dollars per annum.
