In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Two.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE AUTHORITY OF CITIES AND TOWNS TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR LOCAL COUNCILS FOR THE AGING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Clause (49) of section 5 of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 361 of the acts of 1957, is
3 hereby amended by striking out, in line 4, the words "one
4 thousand" and inserting in place thereof the words:—three
5 thousand,—so as to read as follows:—(49) For the purpose
6 of conducting programs dealing with problems of the aging and
7 to promote facilities for the health, education, welfare and
8 recreation of the aging, as authorized by section eight B, not in
9 excess of three thousand dollars annually.
