AN ACT REQUIRING A NEW BASIS OF APPORTIONMENT OF STATE AND COUNTY TAXES TO BE MADE ON THE FIRST DAY OF APRIL IN NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-TWO AND ON THE FIRST DAY OF APRIL IN EVERY FIFTH YEAR THEREAFTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 559 of the acts of 1945 is hereby amended by striking
2 out the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the follow-
3 ing paragraph:—

4 The amount of property and the proportion of every thousand
5 dollars of state tax for each city and town in the several counties
6 of the commonwealth, as contained in the following schedule,
7 are hereby established, and shall constitute a basis of appor-
8 tionment for state and county taxes for the years nineteen hundred
9 and forty-six to nineteen hundred and sixty-one, inclusive, and
10 another shall be made on the first day of April in nineteen hundred
11 and sixty-two and on the first day of April in every fifth year
12 thereafter.
