AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF MAYNARD TO USE A PORTION OF MEMORIAL PARK IN SAID TOWN FOR MUNICIPAL PARKING PURPOSES AND THE DEDICATION OF CERTAIN TOWN LAND FOR PARK PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter five hundred and seventy-three of the
2 acts of nineteen hundred and fifty is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter three hundred and eight of the acts of
2 nineteen hundred and fifty-five is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. The town of Maynard is hereby authorized to
2 use for municipal parking purposes that portion of certain park
3 land known as Memorial Park, being lots numbered 4, 5 and 9
4 as shown on plan of land entitled "Land in Maynard owned by
5 the Town of Maynard, Land on Nason St. and Summer St.,
6 Memorial Park and Parking Lot, Harlan E. Tuttle, Surveyor,"
7 dated November 27, 1961, in consideration of the dedication by
8 said town of certain land owned by said town for park purposes,
9 adjacent to and to be a part of said Memorial Park, and being
10 lots numbered 1, 6 and 8 as shown on said hereinabove men-
11 tioned plan.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall be submitted to the voters of said
2 town at the annual town meeting in the current year in the form
3 of the following question, which shall be placed upon the official

4 ballot to be used for the election of town officers at said meet-
5 ing: — “Shall an act passed by the General Court in the current
6 year entitled, ‘An Act authorizing the town of Maynard to use
7 a portion of Memorial Park in said town for municipal parking
8 purposes and the dedication of certain town land for park pur-
9 poses’, be accepted?” If a majority of the votes in answer to
10 said question is in the affirmative this act shall take full effect,
11 but not otherwise.
