AN ACT PROVIDING TENURE FOR THE INCUMBENT OF THE OFFICE OF ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT OF THE WATER DISTRICT OF THE TOWN OF LUNENBERG.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The tenure of office of the incumbent of the office
2 of assistant superintendent of the water district in the town of
3 Lunenburg shall be unlimited, but he may be removed there-
4 from for cause after hearing in the manner provided by section
5 forty-three of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its acceptance by
2 the prudential committee, or board having similar powers, of
3 the town of Lunenburg, but not otherwise.
