RESOLUTIONS MEMORIALIZING THE CONGRESS AND THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES TO ENACT LEGISLATION TO PROVIDE MEDICAL CARE FOR THE AGED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE SOCIAL SECURITY LAW.

Whereas, There are millions of citizens of the United States of advanced age who are unable to pay for adequate medical care; and

Whereas, It is of prime importance that the needs of such aged persons be provided for; therefore be it

Resolved, That the General Court of Massachusetts respectfully urges the Congress and the President of the United States to enact legislation to provide medical care for the aged under the Social Security Law; and be it further

Resolved, That the Secretary of the Commonwealth transmit forthwith copies of these resolutions to the President of the United States, to the presiding officer of each branch of the Congress of the United States, and to each member thereof from this Commonwealth.
