AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS TO ESTABLISH A MEDICAL SCHOOL IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 75 of the General Laws is hereby amended by insert-
2 ing after section 32, added by chapter 493 of the acts of 1960,
3 the following caption and section: —

4 MEDICAL SCHOOL.

5 *Section 33.* The trustees of the University of Massachusetts
6 shall construct and maintain a medical school to be affiliated
7 with the university. The medical school shall be located in the
8 city of Boston and shall be known as University of Massachu-
9 setts Medical School. The trustees shall use therefor land,
10 buildings and equipment hereafter transferred to it and such
11 further land, buildings, equipment and facilities as may be
12 constructed under authorization of the general court. The
13 trustees are authorized and directed to make plans and to work
14 with all state and federal agencies and to accept grants or match-
15 ing funds which are available or may become available from the
16 federal government or any other source, public or private, for
17 constructing, improving, expanding, and/or equipping the medi-
18 cal school established hereunder.

19 The University of Massachusetts Medical School shall be so
20 maintained and operated as to comply with the standards ap-
21 proved by nationally recognized medical associations for ac-
22 credited schools of medicine.
